



FileMaker Pro 11 and FileMaker Pro 11 Advanced v4 Updater

Software description

This software updates FileMaker Pro 11 or FileMaker Pro 11 Advanced to version 11.0v4.

Updater Details

Updated in FileMaker Pro 11.0v4

Data Formatting:

- OS X Lion only: Addressed an issue with some date field formats showing Asian characters.
- OS X Lion only: Addressed an issue with not being able to use zero or negative numbers in data formatting in the Inspector and in some controls in the Chart Setup dialog.

Who should install this software?

Install this software if you are using any of the configurations listed below. Please verify that you are using the appropriate updater for your product.

Installation instructions

To ensure a smooth installation, disable virus detection software before applying the update, and re-enable it after you are finished.

This update will require approximately 500 MB of free space on your hard disk.

1. Quit FileMaker Pro or FileMaker Pro Advanced 11. Other applications can remain open.
2. Double-click the appropriate FileMaker Pro or FileMaker Pro Advanced 11.0v4 updater program for the platform and product you are using.
3. Read and accept the displayed license agreement, then proceed as directed.
4. Click **Update** to update your software. After the update has completed, you will see a message confirming the successful installation of the new version.

If you have more than one copy of FileMaker Pro 11 or FileMaker Pro 11 Advanced installed on the computer, you will be prompted to select one of each product you want to update. You are required to update both products. There is no option to update just one of them.

5. Quit the updater and open the new version of FileMaker Pro or FileMaker Pro Advanced to verify that the update was successful.

The version information may not be updated until the next time you log in or restart.

If the update does not complete successfully, try the following:

1. Create backup copies of any files you saved in the FileMaker Pro 11 or FileMaker Pro 11 Advanced application folder.
2. Remove FileMaker Pro 11 or FileMaker Pro 11 Advanced.
3. Install FileMaker Pro or FileMaker Pro Advanced version 11.0v1, 11.0v2 using your original installation program.
4. Run the updater program again.
