## FileMaker Pro 10 and FileMaker Pro 10 Advanced v3 Updater

---

### Software description

This software updates FileMaker Pro 10 or FileMaker Pro 10 Advanced to version 10.0v3.

### Updater Details

#### New in FileMaker Pro 10.0v3

1. Import/Export
  - DBF import and export are available.
  - *Mac OS X*: Addressed an issue to prevent a failure when attempting to export Excel (\*.xls) without Rosetta installed.
2. Excel
  - Addressed an issue where an Excel file could be created displaying data under the wrong header if a field was removed using the Modify Table View feature.
  - Addressed an issue where the application could crash if you imported an Excel 2007 file that contains a copied worksheet with named ranges.
3. Calculations
  - Addressed an issue where the Random calculation function could generate non-random values on certain machines. The Random calculation will generate values greater than 0 and less than 1. The value will never be 1.
4. Recovery
  - Addressed an issue that causes custom functions to occasionally get corrupted during recovery.
  - Addressed an issue that causes recovery to report no issues when there are invalid data blocks in the file.
5. SMTP Mail
  - Addressed an issue with some SMTP servers that could lead to the BCC email recipients being shown inappropriately.
  - Addressed an issue where UTF-8 data is not being encoded correctly in SMTP mail.
6. Printing and PDF
  - *Mac OS X*: Addressed an issue where the application would crash when printing to host-based printer models.
  - Addressed an issue where saving records to PDF could crash if the starting page number was not 1 and the layout extended beyond one page, or for database with radio buttons.
7. Networking
  - Addressed an issue where a file set to ask a user to change the password on next login fails to change the password if the client and server are not the same version.
8. External Data Sources
  - Addressed an issue where a FileMaker-based number field added to an external data source table does not display a zero.
9. General
  - Addressed an issue where Auto-Complete in a field with multiple lined data fails to function unless you are on the last empty line of the text field.
  - Addressed an issue where a file set to use the system formats would still insert the date in layout mode with the file format, which may not match the system format.
  - Addressed a formula issue in the script for the New Layout/Report dialog to correctly account for localized formats to enter the correct view mode after a layout is created.

## 10. IWP

- Addressed an issue for some customers with Instant Web Publishing that causes any custom home page in the Web Folder in the FileMaker application folder to be ignored. The problem could also prevent the contents of a container field from being visible in a browser if the Instant Web Publishing solution refers to files stored in the Web folder.

## 11. CPU

- Addressed an issue where CPU utilization may be unnecessarily high in certain circumstances involving custom menus, particularly when used with Citrix Presentation Server and Terminal Services.

### Installation instructions

To ensure a smooth installation, disable virus detection software before applying the update, and re-enable it after you are finished.

This update will require approximately 800 MB of free space on your hard disk. Note: On Windows, you may be prompted to insert your original installation CD or locate the original installation software during the update process.

- Quit FileMaker 10. Other applications can remain open.
- Double-click the appropriate FileMaker 10.0v3 updater program for the platform and product you are using.
- Read and accept the displayed license agreement, then proceed as directed.
- Click **Update** (Mac OS) or **Next**, then **Update** (Windows) to update your software. After the update has completed, you will see a message confirming the successful installation of the new version.

Mac OS: If you have more than one copy of FileMaker Pro 10.0v1 or FileMaker Pro 10.0v1 Advanced installed on the computer, you will be prompted to select the copy you want to update.

- Quit the updater and open the new version of FileMaker to verify that the update was successful.

Mac OS: The version information may not be updated until the next time you log in.

If the update does not complete successfully, try reinstalling the previous version of FileMaker Pro 10 or FileMaker Pro 10 Advanced using your original installation program and then run the updater again, or do the following:

Mac OS:

1. Move the FileMaker Pro application file from the "FileMaker.old" folder to your original "FileMaker Pro 10" or "FileMaker Pro 10 Advanced" folder. Choose to replace the existing file.
2. Run the updater program again.

Windows:

1. Create backup copies of any files you saved in the FileMaker Pro 10 or FileMaker Pro 10 Advanced application folder.
2. Use the Add/Remove Programs (Windows XP) or Programs and Features (Windows Vista) control panel to remove FileMaker Pro 10 or FileMaker Pro 10 Advanced.
3. Install FileMaker Pro or FileMaker Pro Advanced version 10.0v1 using your original installation program.
4. Run the updater program again.

If, after following the steps above, you are still unable to successfully update to FileMaker Pro or FileMaker Pro Advanced 10.0v3, contact FileMaker Technical Support for assistance.

### Silent Install Instructions (Windows Only)

Performing a silent install is a one-step process. The following is the basic syntax of the command that needs to be entered at the Command Prompt:

- **FileMaker Pro**

Step 1: "msiexec -i "<path FileMaker Pro 10.msi file>\ FileMaker Pro 10.msi" /q"

Step 2: "msiexec /fa "<path to FileMaker Pro 10.msi file>\ FileMaker Pro 10.msi" /q"

- **FileMaker Pro Advanced**

Step 1: "msiexec -i "<path to FileMaker Pro 10 Advanced.msi file>\ FileMaker Pro 10 Advanced.msi" /q"

Step 2: "msiexec /fa "<path FileMaker Pro 10 Advanced.msi file>\ FileMaker Pro 10 Advanced.msi" /q"

The silent install options are:

**Note:** Do not use any of the advertisement flags such as /j, /ju, or /jm at the command line with this updater. (These flags are unsupported and may cause known installation problems.) On Microsoft Windows Vista, the command prompt must be run as an administrator. (Right-click the executable, cmd.exe, then select "Run as administrator" from the shortcut menu).
