Unlocking Your Trial

At any time during your 30-day trial, you can unlock the software to convert it to either the full version of FileMaker Server 10 or FileMaker Server 10 Advanced by simply purchasing the software and entering a valid License Key for either product. Here's how:

1. Purchase FileMaker Server 10 or FileMaker Server 10 Advanced from WinSoft* eStore at www.winsoft-international.com.
2. Start FileMaker Server Admin Console by entering <http://localhost:16000> in a web browser on the master machine and clicking Start Admin Console.
3. Choose Start Database Server from the Server menu.
4. Choose Update FileMaker Server License from the Help menu.
5. In the Update License Key dialog box, enter the information required and a valid License Key for either FileMaker Server 10 or FileMaker Server 10 Advanced.
6. Click Update to unlock your 30-day trial, then click Close

Unlocking an Expired Trial

When your 30-day trial period expires, the Database Server stops, and the software will no longer fully function. However, your databases and settings are preserved.

You can unlock the software to convert it to either the full version of FileMaker Server 10 or FileMaker Server 10 Advanced by starting the Database Server and entering a valid License Key before the Database Server stops again in a few minutes. No re-installation is required. Here's how:

1. Purchase FileMaker Server 10 or FileMaker Server 10 Advanced from WinSoft* eStore at www.winsoft-international.com.
2. Start FileMaker Server Admin Console by entering <http://localhost:16000> in a web browser on the master machine and clicking Start Admin Console.
3. Choose Start Database Server from the Server menu.
4. Choose Update FileMaker Server License from the Help menu.
5. In the Update License Key dialog box, enter the information required and a valid License Key for either FileMaker Server 10 or FileMaker Server 10 Advanced.
6. Click Update to unlock your 30-day trial, then click Close.
