FileMaker Server 10.0v2 Updater

Software description

This software updates version 10.0v1 of FileMaker® Server to 10.0v2. You can see the version number of your current installation on the FileMaker Server 10 Admin Console Start Page.

Updater Details

New in FileMaker Server 10.0.2.206

- 1.1. When a backup occurred while a record modification was in process, there was a chance that the backup file's index would be out of sync with the data that was in that record. This problem has been fixed.
- 1.2. An authentication problem with FileMaker Pro clients connecting to a database hosted on FileMaker Server 10 running on Windows has been fixed. The authentication problem occurs when external accounts are used to log in to the server to view their list of databases. The server setting "File Display Filter" must be set to "List only the databases each user is authorized to access".
- 1.3. A problem has been fixed that would cause the summary report generated by the PHP Site Assistant to ignore the "Field to Group by" option.
- 1.4. HTML embedded in the Home page of a site generated by the PHP Site Assistant was not being rendered. This problem has been fixed.
- 1.5. Schedules simultaneously running Export to XML scripts would intermittently fail to produce export files. This problem has been fixed.
- 1.6. DBF file types are now available for Import/Export schedules.
- 1.7. On Microsoft Windows Vista or 2008 Server, restarting the FileMaker Server service while FileMaker Performance Counters are active no longer causes the DBS to crash.

Installation Instructions (Windows Vista, 2003 Server and 2008 Server)

To ensure a smooth installation, disable virus detection software before applying the update, and re-enable it after you are finished. You may be prompted to insert your original installation CD or locate the original installation software during the update process.

1. Disconnect all clients and close all files.
2. In the FileMaker Server Admin Console, stop Web Publishing and the Database Server.
3. Quit the FileMaker Server Admin Console, the Start Page and PHP Site Assistant if they are running.
4. In the Windows Services Console, select Services (Local).
5. Select the FileMaker Server service, then choose Action menu > Stop.

Install the new software

1. Read the license agreement. If you agree to the terms, double-click setup.exe.
2. Click "Update", and then proceed as directed.
After the update has completed, you will see a message confirming the successful installation of the new version.
3. Click "Finish" to quit the updater when completed.
4. Open the FileMaker Server 10 Admin Console Start Page.
5. Under Software Update, the Current Installed Version should now read 10.0.2.206.

Installation Instructions (Mac OS X 10.4.x and 10.5.x)

To ensure a smooth installation, disable virus detection software before applying the update, and re-enable it after you are finished.

Before applying the update

1. Disconnect all clients and close all files.
2. In the FileMaker Server Admin Console, stop Web Publishing and the Database Server.
3. Quit the FileMaker Server Admin Console, the Start Page and PHP Site Assistant if they are running.

Install the new software

1. Read the license agreement. If you agree to the terms double-click the FileMaker Server 10 v2 updater.
2. Click "Update", and then proceed as directed.
After the update has completed, you will see a message confirming the successful installation of the new version.
3. Quit the updater when completed.
4. Open the FileMaker Server 10 Admin Console Start Page.
5. Under Software Update, the Current Installed Version should now read 10.0.2.206.

If the update does not complete successfully, reinstall the full version of FileMaker Server 10 using your original installation program, then run the FileMaker Server 10.0v2 Update again. If you are still unable to successfully update to FileMaker Server 10.0v2, contact FileMaker Technical Support for assistance.
